## Memorandum of Agreement

This Memorandum of Agreement is entered into by the Illinois Council of Police and the City of Casey, collectively, "the Parties." This Memorandum serves to incorporate the change to the City's residency requirement. Accordingly, the Parties agree as follows;

- 1. The Parties' Collective Bargaining Agreement contains a 12-mile residency requirement.
- 2. On August 8, 2023 the City Council increased the residency requirement to 25 miles.
- 3. Therefore, Article 20 Section 3 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement is changed as follows to reflect the change in the residency requirement:

## Section 20.3. Residency

An officer may reside outside the City limits, provided that he does not reside further than twenty-five (25) miles from the City's limits. If an officer resides outside the City's limits, he will not be picked up nor returned at the beginning or end of his shifts in a city vehicle, and he may not leave the city limits during his lunch/dinner break.
